1. When is the application due?

The application and letters of recommendation are due by April 1st.

2. Do I have to be a high school senior?

Yes, to be eligible for the Phillip Dorsey Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a graduating, high school senior
- Plan to attend an accredited and approved four—year institution within the United States
- Show leadership potential
- Demonstrate a dedication to community service
- Present evidence of financial need
- Be a United States citizen

3. Can I apply even if I haven't been accepted to a college yet?

Yes, you may apply for our scholarship if you haven't been accepted to a college yet. However, the awarding of the scholarship will require verification of college admission and enrollment.

4. How do you define "financial need"?

Up Rising Stars Inc. understands that there is a wide array of financial need. We will look at each application on a case by case basis via the entire scholarship applications. Please do not provide any personal financial information (W2 forms, paystubs, etc.)

5. How do you define community service and civic engagement?

We are looking for students that address community needs, whether it is starting a school organization, reading to local students, volunteering in the food pantry, or building houses for the needy, Phillip Dorsey Scholarship recipients are rising stars.

6. Where do I send my application?

7. Can I download the application, complete, and send in a hard copy? Yes, hard copy applications are only accepted.

8. Who should complete the letters of recommendation?

Your two professional letters of recommendation should be submitted by someone who can provide information about your character, academic accomplishments, community service involvement and extracurricular activities. Possible recommenders to consider, but are not limited to, are: a guidance counselor, teacher, athletic coach, mentor, or employer.

9. Is it necessary for me to send my official College Board or ACT test scores and Transcript?

Yes, it is necessary for you to send your official College Board or ACT test scores and official transcript with your application or request for the College Board or ACT to send your scores to Up Rising Stars Inc. We are aware that seniors will not have the entire official 12 grade completed as they are still in high school but they are to send the official transcript up until the current term they are in school.

10. Do you grant extensions for late applications?

No, we are unable to grant extensions for late applications.

12. When will I find out if I received the scholarship award?
